

EVALUATION OF TECHNICAL PROPOSALS OF DHAPA SITE IN WEST BENGAL (Ref:RFP NO: 002/C/WBPCB/WB-CBIPMP dated 10.02.2011)

Request for Proposals from Shortlisted Firms

After approval from World Bank, the RFPs were sent to the short listed Consultants on 10.02.2011. This was followed with a pre-bid conference on 14.03.2011 at 11.00 a.m. where the representatives of the shortlisted Consultants participated. The written queries received through e-mail earlier as well as the queries raised in the meeting were clarified in the said meeting. The proceedings of the pre-bid conference along with answers to the queries of the Consultants were sent to the short listed Consultants with the copy to World bank for information. The answers to the queries of the short listed firms did not result into any change of the RFP.

Receipt of proposals

As scheduled, bids were received in the Office of the Deputy Project Director, CBIPM Project up to 2.00 p.m. on 29/03/2011. Of the six shortlisted Consultants, only four Consultants submitted their RFPs with both the technical as well as financial proposals in two separate sealed envelopes and their names are as under:-

1. **COWI A/S**, Denmark
2. **SCOTT WILSON INDIA PRIVATE LIMITED**, New Delhi-110044
3. **CSD INGENIEURS SA**, Switzerland.
4. **Egis Bceom International** , France

Out of six short listed firms,1)**HYDRO PLAN**, Germany and 2) **Langan International**, ABU DHABI, UAE did not submit their RFP .

A Committee was formed with due approval of Project Director, CBIPMP for the opening of bids received. The Committee opened the technical proposals on 29.03.2011 at 2.30 p.m. The financial proposals of all the four firms obtained in separate sealed covers were taken out and kept inside another sealed envelope and locked, to be opened on the day proposed for financial bid opening.

Technical Evaluation

FORMATION OF TECHNICAL EVALUATION TEAM

The Evaluation Committee comprising of five members including two experts from outside and one representative of Ministry of environment & Forests, Govt. of India under the chairmanship of Deputy Project Director was formed with due approval of Project Director, CBIPMP for evaluation of the technical proposals.

Technical Evaluation

Four technical proposals received were opened and were subsequently evaluated by the Evaluation Committee members. The evaluation has been done in accordance with the evaluation criteria and sub-criteria stipulated in the RFP and agreed with the World Bank. The evaluation was made by the committee based on the capability of the Consultants on the subject and requirements of the Project, their strengths and weaknesses. The results of Technical proposal after approval from World bank are given below.
